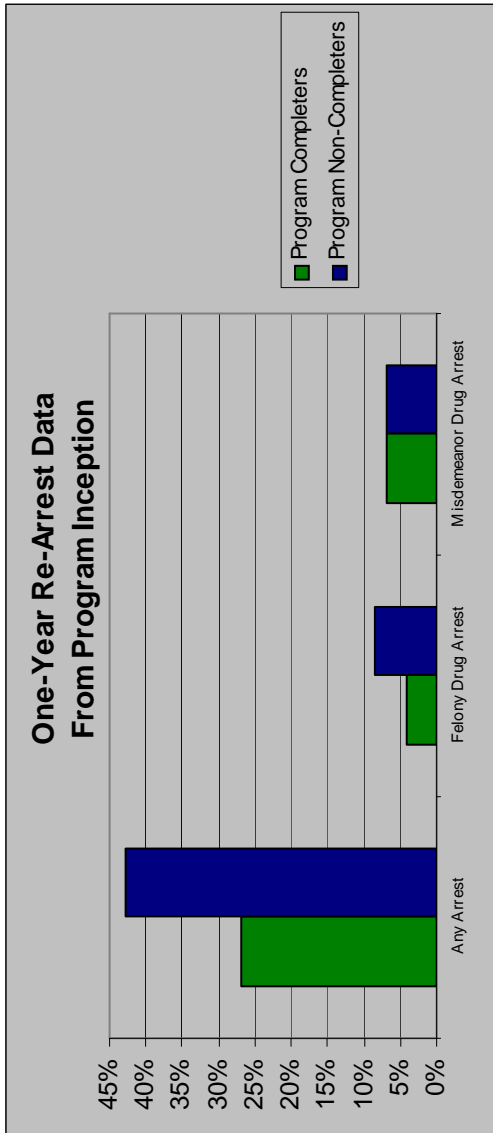

Anti-Drug Initiative

The Anti-Drug Initiative Program, which began in 1999, is an innovative expansion of the continuum of care for drug-involved offenders in Florida's Seventh Judicial Circuit.

ADI provides research-based substance abuse treatment for non-violent, first and second-time drug offenders. Treatment services associated with ADI were developed by Stewart-Marchman-Act Behavioral Healthcare based on program models that have been scientifically evaluated and demonstrated effective with drug offenders.



Online ADI



The Online ADI Program is a new addition to the services already provided. This program offers participants access to complete the Level I ADI program online rather than attending groups at an agency location. It also accommodates individuals who reside outside of the area or prefer online to outpatient services. Online ADI includes a 30-day intervention plus urinalysis. What are the benefits of an online program?

- Program can be completed from home
- Website is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- No transportation is required
- Access to technical support
- Reduces the penalty cost of a misdemeanor charge by 40%

Outpatient Level 1

Outpatient Level I ADI is a six-week intervention program. Participants are offered services in our Daytona Beach, DeBary, and New Smyrna Beach offices. The program consists of one intake session, four group sessions, one discharge session, and random urinalysis throughout the program. Successful completion will result in the participant's criminal case being diverted from the court system.



Outpatient Level 2

Level 2 ADI is a six-month intensive intervention program. Level 2 offers longer, more intensive intervention when warranted. Participants are offered services at our Daytona Beach and DeBary offices. The program consists of one intake session, ten group sessions, and three individual sessions in addition to random urinalysis throughout participation.
