ADMISSION TO OUR PROGRAMS

Enrichment/Step-Up: Participants must be 16 years or older and have a documented disability with functional limitations that impairs his/her ability to live, work, learn and fully function independently in the community and meet funding source criteria.

Supported Employment: Participants must meet eligibility requirements of the Department of Education Vocational Rehabilitation.
