One of SMA's most innovative programs, sponsored by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) through a five year grant since 2005, reaches out to the community touching those in high risk areas who may not have access to information, referral or testing for STD's including HIV.

Newly refunded on the first of October, 2010 for the next five years, the program will focus not only on The original target population of high risk areas in Volusia county but also a sub-target population of reentry individuals will be encouraged to participate in services through outreach to the Department of Corrections, County jails and Probation providers.



This program has participated in many local events including health fairs and community awareness projects. Over the last five years more than 3,000 rapid HIV tests have been administered to people in Volusia and Flagler Counties by POM staff.
