Recovery Month (created in 1992 by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration's (SAMHSA's) Center for Substance Abuse Treatment (CSAT) is an annual observance that takes place during the month of September. Recovery Month serves to educate the public on substance abuse as a national health crisis, addiction is a treatable disease, and recovery is possible. Communities across the nation plan and develop activities to bring awareness of addiction. Stewart-Marchman-Act (SMA) Behavioral Healthcare Keep Kids Drug Free Prevention Center and Florida Recovery Month have put together a continuing education activity focusing on prescription drug abuse. Prescription drug abuse is a significant problem in the United States, and has been coined the "Silent Epidemic".
