All interested persons over 18 are invited to apply as a volunteer. Each volunteer is covered by the agency's liability insurance. Residential programs are open seven days a week and outpatient services are provided Monday through Friday 8 am to 5 pm. There are opportunities for weekend and evening hours with permission of the program supervisor. All Stewart-Marchman-Act Behavioral Healthcare facilities are accessible by bus.



Volunteers are processed through the Resource Coordinator's office at the administrative offices on Willis Avenue in Daytona Beach. Because of the special clientele we serve, background screens are necessary and photo ID is required. Our Resource Coordinator will work with you through the screening process prior to your placement.
